<b>1.</b>	<p><b>Recommendation 1 - The Community Safety Service should continue to work in partnership with the voluntary and community sector to expand their work on promoting a better understanding of safeguarding risks</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What is the role of the Prevent Education and Engagement Officer around young people transitioning from Children’s to Adult services? What training does the Prevent Education and Engagement Officer receive?</li> <li>• The next Children’s Services Ofsted inspection will look at partnership arrangements. How is the Council developing a multi-agency safeguarding approach to safeguarding young people at risk and how ready is the Council for this Ofsted inspection in terms of partnerships with the voluntary and community sector to promote understanding of safeguarding risks?</li> <li>• What challenges/threats does the Council see to embedding safeguarding with the VCS and how is the Council going to address these?</li> </ul>
