Re: Thames Tunnel Phase s48 consultation – request for information

I write again on behalf of London Borough of Tower Hamlets ("LBTH"), local authority consultee and landowner in respect of Thames Water's proposals to carry out works connected with the construction of the Thames Tunnel in the location known as the Foreshore Option in King Edward Memorial Park.

LBTH continues to assess the information provided by Thames Water as part of the s48 Planning Act 2008 consultation in order to respond within the requisite deadline.
