3.0 Background

- 3.1 There arethree separate applications for standard Temporary Event Notices. Enclosed arecopies of the applications in **Appendices 1-3**..
- 3.2 The applicant has described the nature of the application as follows:Late Night Refreshment
- 3.3 The premises that has been applied for is: Subway, 222 Brick Lane, London E1 6SA
- 3.4 The dates for the first application that have been applied for are as follows:22nd to 24th November 2013, please see **Appendix 1**.
- 3.5 The dates for the second application that have been applied for are as follows: 29th November to 1st December 2013, please see **Appendix 2**.
- 3.6 The dates for the second application that have been applied for are as follows: 6thto 8thDecember 2013, please see **Appendix 3**.
- 3.7 The times for all three applications that have been applied for are as follows:
 From 23:00 hours to 04:00 hours.
- 3.8 A map showing the relevant premises and immediate area is included as **Appendix 4**.

4.0 Temporary Event Notices

- 4.1 Temporary Event Notices (TENs) are a creation of the Licensing Act 2003. They provide a method by which licensable activities can be carried out on a temporary basis (max. 168hrs) without a licence. The maximum number that can attend at any one time is 499. At least 10 full working days' notice must be given to the licensing authority. When a TEN cannot be obtained, for example the event is over 499, then a full premises licence must be obtained, for a limited duration.
- 4.2 The licensing authority cannot oppose an application, (nor can local residents or businesses. The licensing authority must reject any application that does not meet the rules as to numbers, maximum per year etc. The limits are now as follows: 12 TEN per calendar year or 21 days. The responsible authorities that can object is the Metropolitan Police or Environmental Protection.
- 4.3 The Police and Environmental Protection can object on the grounds that allowing the event to go ahead will undermine one of the Licensing Objectives.

- 4.4 Following an objection by the relevant responsible authority one or more conditions may be imposed by the Licensing Authority
 - (a) if it considers it appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives to do so,
 - (b) the conditions are also imposed on a premises licence or club premises certificate that has effect in respect of the same premises, or any part of the same premises, as the temporary event notice, and
 - (c) the conditions would not be inconsistent with the carrying out of the licensable activities under the temporary event notice.
- 4.5 Where the authority decides to impose one or more conditions;
 - (a) the authority must give the premises user notice of the decision;
 - (b) the notice must be accompanied by a separate statement (the "statement of conditions") which sets out the conditions that have been imposed on the temporary event notice; and
 - (c) a copy of the notice and statement of conditions must be given to each relevant party.
- 4.6 LATE TENs have been created through the Police Reform and Social Responsibilities Act 2011, a Late TEN can be made no later than FIVE working days and no earlier than NINE working days before the event. The limits to these applications are no more than 2 for a non-personal licence holder or no more than 10 for a personal licence holder.
- 4.7 The Police and Environmental Protection can object to Late TENs, if an objection is made the Licensing Authority must issue a counter notice advising the event cannot take place.

5.0 **Objections**

5.1 The Police objection all three applications is contained in **Appendix 5**.

6.0 Advice to Members

- 6.1 The Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 have amended legislation whereby Environmental Protection alongside Police can object to Temporary Event Notice under any of the licensing objectives.
- 6.2 This hearing is required by the Licensing Act 2003. As always the decision is on the civil burden of proof, i.e. the balance of probability.
- 6.3 Members can consider any of the licensing objectives. Other matters can also be dealt with elsewhere by primary legislation.

- 6.4 Premises users are not required to be on the premises for the entire duration of the event authorised by the TEN, but they will remain liable to prosecution for certain offences that may be committed at the premises during the period covered by it. These include, for example, the offences of the sale of alcohol to a person who is drunk; persistently selling alcohol to children; and allowing disorderly conduct on licensed premises.
- 6.5 The police or local authority exercising environmental health functions may contact the premises user to discuss their objections and try to come to an agreement which will allow the proposed licensable activities to proceed. The TEN can be modified. If there is no agreement, the licensing authority must hold a hearing to consider the notice.

7.0 Cumulative Impact Policy

- 7.1 The Council is aware that the majority of late night licensed premises is concentrated within one area of the Borough, Brick Lane Area, and has therefore declared a Cumulative Impact Zone with effect from 1st November 2013.
- 7.2 It recognises that because of the number and density of licensed premises selling alcohol, on and off the premises and the provision of late night refreshment (sale of hot food after 11pm), there might be exceptional problems of nuisance, disturbance and/or disorder outside or away from those licensed premises as a result of their combined effect.
- 7.3 The extract from the Licensing Policy and map of the Zone is attached in **Appendix 6.**
- 8.0 Legal Comments
- 8.1 The Council's legal officer will give advice at the hearing.

- 9.1 There are no financial implications in this report.

Re: Application for a TEN - Subway, 222, Brick Lane, London E1

I wish to oppose the three TEN applications for the above premises all sent via email on 03/11/13 and received by police on 04/11/13. The applicant's is Mr. Mohammed ALAM.

The first TEN is for Friday 22/11/13 to Sunday 24/11/13 for the sale of hot food and drinks between 23:00 hours and 04:00 hours.

The second TEN is for Friday 29/11/13 to Sunday 01/12/13 for the sale of hot food and drinks between 23:00 hours and 04:00 hours.

The third TEN is for Friday 06/12/13 to Sunday 08/12/13 for the sale of hot food and drinks between 23:00 hours and 04:00 hours.

Firstly, the police in particular note that this application falls within the **Special** Cumulative Impact Policy for the Brick Lane Area, adopted on 18th September 2013 by the Council.

In regards to the latter, whilst the police will make their own representations below; it is assumed that paragraph 8.4 of the Licensing Policy is invoked by the Council, namely:

".....Where the premises are situated in the cumulative impact zone and a representation is received, the licence will be refused. To rebut this presumption the applicant would be expected to show through the operating schedule and where appropriate with supporting evidence that the operation of the premises will not add to the cumulative impact already being experienced."

Separate to the above, if the applications are granted I believe the Crime and Disorder objective, as defined in the Licensing Act 2003 would be undermined.

At present, the venue does not hold a premises licence and therefore cannot open between 23:00 hours and 05:00 hours to sell hot food or drinks. There has been two previous applications for TEN'S, which the police objected too (they were for Friday 08/11/13 to Sunday 10/11/13 for the sale of hot food and drinks between 23:00 hours and 04:00 hours and Friday 15/11/13 to Sunday 17/11/13 for the sale of hot food and drinks between 23:00 hours and 04:00 hours).

On Sunday, 27/10/13 at 00:10 hours, PC 291HT O'Rourke attended the premises and witnessed the sale of hot food and drink, in a statement dated 27/10/13 he states:

"At approximately 00:10 I attended the premises and saw that a male had just bought a sandwich with melted cheese on it. A female came in and bought a hot tea. Two other males then bought meatball sandwiches, which were steaming hot".

PC O'ROURKE then spoke the manager who identified himself as Mr. Mohammed ALAM, DOB 10/02/1983, who told him that he also ran the Subway in Whitechapel on Mile End Road.

In short Mr. ALAM led PC O'ROURKE to believe that there was a mix up in that Mr. ALAM understood the planning permission granted to the premises as 'A1 no restriction', meant he could open whenever he wanted and that he had emails from the Council confirming this.

I have to say that did not quite ring true and Mr. ALAM was subsequently 'Reported for Process' for the following offences, for which he may be prosecuted at Thames Magistrates for:

- Section 57 (7) of the Licensing Act 2003 Failure to produce a premises licence or a certified copy
- Section 109 (8) of the Licensing Act 2003 Failure to produce a TEN to a police officer.

Mr ALAM was issued with Met Police Licensing Form from 'Book 694' "Notification of alleged offences under the Licensing Act 2003.

In support of my belief that his claim did not ring true (I did not believe he was unaware that he didn't need a premises licence). Mr. LISOWSKI, London Borough of Tower Hamlets Licensing Officer has confirmed to me in a statement dated 29/10/13 that:

"On Monday, 29th April 2013, I received a complaint from a neighbour that Subway, Unit 2, 6-25, Mile End Road, London E1 4TP, was providing late night refreshment without a premises licence. I checked my department records, Subway did not have a premises licence. As part of my investigation of this complaint I wrote a letter for the owner of the Subway at Unit 2, advising him of the law about the provision of late night refreshment. On Thursday, 2nd May 2013 at 16:30 hours I went to Subway, Unit 2 to deliver the letter and asked to speak to the manager. The person I spoke to told me he was the owner and subsequently gave his name as Mohammed ALAM. I explained to him that I was investigating a complaint and I gave him the letter".

I have attached a copy of the letter that Mr. LISOWSKI exhibits as AL/1 in his statement. He has been previously advised of the legislation by the Council and chosen to ignore that advice.

The applicant has clearly committed offences against the Licensing Act 2003 and I have no confidence in him maintaining the Licensing objectives until an application for a full premises licence can be considered.


Additionally Brick Lane suffers from a high amount of anti-social behaviour, to the extent that police statistics show that between 22:00 hours on Friday and 02:00 hours on Monday the London Borough of Tower Hamlets is second only to Westminster (West End/Soho/Covent Garden) for Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) calls to Police in London. Premises offering late night refreshment attract the very people causing the ASB, which prolongs their departure from the area.

The premises also falls within the 'Shoreditch Triangle', which comprises of the triborough wards of Haggerston ward (Hackney), Weavers and Spitalfields & Banglatown wards (Tower Hamlets) and Bunhill Ward (Islington) are four wards which are high crime generators for their respective boroughs especially around Theft Person and the Night Time Economy. Tower Hamlets wards contribute 38% of all Theft Person Offences

Peak times are between Friday 20:00 hours to Saturday 04:00 hours and Saturday 20:00 hours to Sunday 04:00 hours and these 16 hours are responsible for 21% of all the offences.

Sunday also has a peak but from 12:00 hours to 02:00 hours 16% of all crime.

25% of all crime in Spitalfields and Banglatown ward is committed between 20:00 hours to 02:00 hours Friday to Sunday. 20% of all crime in Weavers ward is committed between 20:00 hours to 02:00 hours Friday to Sunday.



The police therefore ask that the TEN'S be refused.

COMPLAINT RE TRADING OUTSIDE OF PERMITTED HOURS

Any premises which sells or supplies hot food and/or hot drink any day, anytime, between the hours of 11pm and 5am the following day requires a premises licence for the provision of late night refreshment.

One of your neighbours has complained that you are remaining open beyond 11pm on a regular basis.

Selling or supplying hot food and/or hot drink between 11pm and 5am is an offence contrary to Section 136 of The Licensing Act. 2003. Because a complaint has been received a licensing officer at some time in the future will check what hours you remain open to.

If you wish to apply for a premises licence for the provision of late night refreshment, an application form can be downloaded from the Council's website.

Appendix 6

Licensing Policy

8 Special Cumulative Impact Policy for the Brick Lane Area

- 8.1 As with many other London Borough's the majority of late night licensed premises are concentrated within one area of the Borough. Following guidance issued under the Licensing Act 2003 a cumulative impact policy was adopted on 18th September 2013 by the Council.
- 8.2 After consultation the Council recognises that because of the number and density of licensed premises selling alcohol, on and off the premises and the provision of late night refreshment (sale of hot food after 11pm) within the Brick Lane Area as defined in Figure One, there might be exceptional problems of nuisance, disturbance and/or disorder outside or away from those licensed premises as a result of their combined effect.
- 8.3 The Licensing Authority is now of the view that the number, type and density of premises selling alcohol for consumption on and off the premises and/or the provision of late night refreshment in the area highlighted in Figure One is having a cumulative impact on the licensing objectives and has therefore declared a cumulative impact zone.
- 8.4 The effect of this Special Cumulative Impact Policy is to create a rebuttable presumption for applications in respect of the sale or supply of alcohol on or off the premises and/or late Night Refreshment for new Premises Licences, Club Premises Certificates or Provisional Statements and applications for variations of existing Premises Licences, Club Premises Certificates (where the modifications are relevant to the issue of cumulative impact for example increases in hours or capacity). Where the premises are situated in the cumulative impact zone and a representation is received, the licence will be refused. To rebut this presumption the applicant would be expected to show through the operating schedule and where appropriate with supporting evidence that the operation of the premises will not add to the cumulative impact already being experienced. This policy does not act as an absolute prohibition on granting/varying new licences in the Cumulative Impact Zone.
- 8.5 The Special Cumulative Impact policy will not be used to revoke an existing licence or certificate and will not be applicable during the review of existing licences.
