In the right hand aisle there was a large sack in clear view to anyone. Inside the sack there was 10,000 non-duty paid cigarettes

This evaded duty amounted to £420.06 were found on the shelf behind the counter and in the rear stock room. This amounted to 186.75 litres of wines During this time I was also at a nearby off-licence. Returning to assist in the search, 249 bottles of mixed wine

Also found were five bottles of counterfeit Smirnoff vodka. £43.13 of evaded duty

Customs seized these goods and issued a Seizure Notice.
