Key Events/Announcements

Aberfeldy Arrest:

Like many people I was deeply concerned to see videos of the arrest on Aberfeldy last week and met residents with ward councillors the next day to hear their views and reassure them.

Although social media doesn't always show everything the videos were clearly disturbing. I discussed the incident with senior police commanders sharing our view that it should immediately be referred to the Independent Office for Police Conduct (IOPC) for investigation which it has now been. While we should avoid jumping to conclusions, everyone must be able to feel safe on our streets and have confidence in our police. An independent investigation will help to ensure this.

Last Friday and this Tuesday I attended community events in response to the arrests and will continue work with the police to ensure this matter is fully investigated and resolved.

Summer Activities and tackling holiday hunger:

With the summer weather finally beginning and school holidays on the horizon we are once again running our programme of summer activities with more than 335 free activities including swimming, sports camps, days out, courses as well as schemes to tackle holiday hunger.

Our programme of holiday hunger clubs at 11 schools will provide free lunches for those in need with almost 22,000 meals expected to be offered through the summer.

New online options to access services:

As part of our efforts to embrace technology and improve the way residents can interact with the council, we are introducing Digital Hubs in our Ideas Stores as well as making many of our services available online.

Our aim is to make life easier and more convenient for those who want to access our services online instead of having to take time out of their day to visit a council building.

Residents who want can still contact the council by telephone, and we will still provide face to face personal support to those who need it at all of our award-winning Idea Stores as well as Rushmead One Stop Shop.

Liveable Streets:

Earlier this year we launched our £15m Liveable Streets programme, which aims to improve the look and feel of public spaces in neighbourhoods across the borough. This will make it easier, safer and more convenient to get around by foot, bike and public transport. Work has begun in a number of areas to seek resident views on how we can make their streets look and work better.

Ofsted:

The re-inspection of Children's Services has now taken place and the final report will be published on 22nd July. Over the past two years we have had a relentless focus on improving our children's services and ensuring our young people have the best start in life. We know we have made major progress and hope that next week's Ofsted report will reflect this.

Local Community Fund:

Our new Local Community Fund will award £2.6m a year in funding to local community organisations to run projects across the borough. The recommendations of the independently evaluated bids will be considered at Overview and Scrutiny and Cabinet in the coming weeks. We have a fantastic Voluntary and Community sector in the borough, and we are proud to be continuing to support them.

The Mela:

The Mela was a great success with over 40,000 people estimated to have attended. It was a vibrant and colourful celebration of Bangladeshi culture for all the family and a great example of the kind of cultural exchanges which make our diverse borough such an exciting and interesting place to live.

Pride month:

Alongside the Mayor of Hackney I unveiled a new rainbow crossing on Hackney Road to help celebrate Pride month. We are also flying the Pride flag at the Town Hall Our No Place for Hate Champions Project has once again been recognised with an #EndHateTogether award from the London-wide HEAR Network, an equality and human rights organisation.

Bow Community Hub:

We've opened our latest Community Hub in Bow. The Bow Community Hub in Twelvetreves Crescent is the latest in a series of 'community hubs' to be built by the Council to provide modern spaces for our community to get together.

Progress to 2,000 council homes:

Proposals to build 17 new council homes on the site of a former children's home have been given the go ahead. Permission for the four townhouses and 13 flats in Norman Grove, Bow, was granted at a meeting of the council's development committee on Thursday.

The properties will have a mixture of one to four bedrooms. They will all be rented at genuinely affordable rates to residents of Tower Hamlets who are on the council's housing register.

Young Mayors:

On June 26th at Cabinet Young Mayor Jaami Barry and his deputies addressed a busy Cabinet meeting to lay out their vision for their term working closely with the Cabinet and the wider council. As we will discuss later on tonight, this is one of a number of things the council is doing to ensure the voice of young people is heard throughout the decision making process.
