Dear Council and Community!

Taking into account the arguments written by the community, I would also like to state what and how I can improve or answer their claims.

Prevention of crime and disorder and public safety:

Of course, we do not serve drunk people or if it is necessary we send them out of the restaurant. I would emphasize that we are not a pub, but a small canteen. Most of the alcoholic beverages we offer are special products purchased from Hungary, so the goods are not cheap either, so that everyone who wants to party can come to us. They will not come to us for a drink for these reasons. These are the products we want to offer, most of them a recommended accompanying drink alongside food.

If we see someone drinking more than they should, we will not serve him and, if necessary, we will ask them to leave the restaurant. We also inform our guests about this rule on the sign placed in the store. Should we notice any disturbance, either indoors or outdoors, we will immediately notify the appropriate authorities and forward the recording to them.

Prevent public nuisance:

Inside, there is quiet, background music on a small Bluetooth speaker, with the sole purpose of filling it with a pleasant feeling when someone comes to us and being able to chat with their friends and family. This music is background music for the additional purpose of shutting off any minor noise in the kitchen from guests, such as the base noise of the fridge. There is not and will not be an outdoor speaker, nor can the current indoor speaker be heard outdoors. We also don't have a loud kitchen or other equipment, so your neighbors aren't bothered by the restaurant!

The restaurant is quite small. Our shop can accommodate a maximum of 10 people at a time, with 4 people on the outside. The smoking will be allowed for a maximum of 5 people in the same time. Additional information about these limits will be posted in the business premises. Thus, the degree of external noise generation is also quite low. We have a special food offer, so the chances of more people gathering are quite low. Furthermore, because space is small, our goal is to serve people quickly and welcome new ones, so keeping it here with alcohol is not our goal.

In Front of Us under construction a new Toilet and it will be usefull for the people around here.

We and Our most of Neighbors want to improve this Street, because it is really quiet now, not like before a few years ago. Many businesses just surviving in this part of Spitalfields. It can help Us get a little bit more income to help Us alive.

Furthermore, the area in front of the store we constantly kept clean, despite the fact that thanks to the market, there are a lot of rubbish all over the street every day. We also bought for an outdoor rubbish bin, due to the possible generation of extra rubbish, so for the first time on the street, we will have our own bin outside not like others.


We are living in this House where the Shop is, so we know the Neighbours and They also know Us well. It is very important for us to have our own and His peace in addition to the whole community, of course.

Protect children from harm

Operation of an active CCTV system in the business premises, installation of a warning sign for customers.

We do not serve juveniles with any alcoholic beverages. Follow the Challenge of 25! Furthermore, as I mentioned, we do not serve a drunk person, we will ask Him to leave if necessary!

If a person under the age of 18 is in our store, we will NOT serve alcohol them! Placing a warning sign in the store again.

Once again, I would like to emphasize that these are some and exclusively Hungarian traditional products, not a wide offer, by no means do we want to create a pub atmosphere with this.

Further arguments:

When we opened our store, we carefully selected the store space. We wanted to make the area more colorful with a *brand new Nationality restaurant with food and drink.* If you look around, you will find plenty of food and drink in the area, with many similar shops side by side, but this kind of restaurant doesn't exist in the entire E1 zone. In England there are only a few Hungarian Shop or restaurants.


This zone is also famous for its color (its multicultures) among the people, so we would like to have a full offer for the customers here.

It is a strong part of Hungarian culture to consume a drink with food in a healthy setting and not intoxicated at all.

Also we appeared on the Spitalfields life magazin. They were write about Us for the community, and we got a lot of positive comments and wishes on the website. Many people were visiting us, and they liked the shop and the Hungarian food. We also have only positive reviews on the social media like Facebook, Google or instagram. people love and support what we stand for.

We are also open to requesting a reduction in the time to sell / serve alcohol to between 10:00 AM-09 or 8:00PM. In line with our current opening hours, we are still open from 11:00 am-08pm. This will also help solve the concerns of you and the community as well.

In the CIZ zone we are on the Yellow zone. (Brick Lane Cumulative Impact Zone). (Low zone, only a bar in front of us, and far away another bar, i think so, this small cuisine does not will disturb the neighborhood.).



We hope that we can reach a common agreement, and you can see that we do not want to operate at the pub level, and the size of the place would not allow this later either!

From those who is present, we are happy to welcome you and see with your own eyes the food, the design, capacity and quality of the place.
