TFL proposed to support mitigation with financial support was that explored.	Yes, due to the LTM negative impact and displaced traffic they offered financial support for some bus priority works and public realm works around Arnold Circus.
how does the council propose the issues that will arise on Arnold circus if the road closures are to be removed.	The option 3 would seek to address the issues that were raised.
local police state that road closures have helped improve crime and Asb has the council explored ways to mitigate crime and ASB if the road closures are to be removed.
