#### 1.0 Additional information received

1.1 Further to publication of the Committee report, an updated BRE Sunlight and Daylight Study, compiled by Right of Light Consulting, has been submitted by the applicant relating to the reconfigured ground floor layout of the western block.

#### 2.0 Assessment of the updated Sunlight and Daylight Report

- 2.1 The updated Sunlight and Daylight Report considers the impact of the revised ground floor layout of the western block and the construction of a 2m high wall along the western boundary of the site upon the living conditions of future occupants of the affected units.
- 2.2 The report demonstrates that despite the construction of the adjacent wall, the reconfigured layout would allow all ground floor habitable rooms to receive sufficient sunlight and daylight to a satisfactory depth to comply with the relevant BRE standards.

#### 3 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 The additional material has been considered and the officer's recommendation remains unchanged.
