EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The site at Brunton Wharf (Yorkshire Road) received planning approval in March 2022 ref: PA/19/02608/A1 and will comprise of 32 x 1, 2, 3 and 4 bedroom social homes for rent. The scheme-specific budget allocation of £12.750m was approved by Cabinet in June 2021.

The planning application was submitted in December 2019. At that time, the Pre-Tender Estimate (PTE) for the build cost was £10.990m. In October 2020, Development Committee resolved to grant permission for the scheme.

However, as a result of design change required by LFB and market conditions, including rising inflation, increasing energy costs and a shortage of materials and labour, the pre-tender estimate price for this contract was higher than originally forecasted. The total scheme costs now exceed the approved budget of £12.750m requiring an additional £4.147m enabling the contract to be awarded and the development to start on site before 31st March 2022, to meet the deadline for the funding requirements.

To fund this budget uplift within the affordability envelope of the HRA Business Plan, Waterloo Gardens will be removed from the current programme, while a re-design to increase the number of new homes takes place, to release its budget allocation of £7.200m for immediate re-allocation. This will provide a funding source for the Brunton Wharf and other schemes.

- Approve the removal of the current Waterloo Gardens scheme and associated budget of £7.200m from the HRA new council homes programme budget of £365.125m as set out in the report to Cabinet in January 2023 and use of £4.147m for the Brunton Wharf scheme

- Approval to appoint contract award for the agreed contract sum
