The public are welcome to attend meetings of the Committee. However seating is limited and offered on a first come first served basis.



Bus: Routes: D3, D6, D7, D8, 15, 108, and 115 all stop near the Town Hall. Docklands Light Railway: Nearest stations are East India: Head across the bridge and then through complex to the Town Hall, Mulberry Place Blackwall station. Across the bus station then turn right to the back of the Town Hall complex, through the gates and archway to the Town Hall. Tube: The closest tube stations are Canning Town and Canary Wharf
