Further to the Section 51 Review served on the Licensing Authority on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2019 I wish to submit additional information.

The Licensing Authority tasked the police with conducting visits to the Queens Head as part of the Late Night Levy enforcement visits.

The table below shows the visits conducted and the comments made by the police officers attending.

He stated that he has never had one and does not know that he needs one but is willing to get one in the future if needed		
18/01/19	23:40 hrs	Venue was in the process of closing, no persons were in the street. Landlord was spoken to and no issues were raised. The garden was not in use.		
20/01/19	00:30 hrs	Attention paid to premises, no persons found to be in the street
