Further to the above premises licence application and Licensing Sub-Committee hearing next week, my client has instructed me to amend the hours on the application.

Following consultation with the local residents, my client would like to reduce the proposed terminal hour for licensable activities by one hour Monday to Saturday and by two hours on Sunday. My client would also like to reduce the proposed terminal opening hours by 30 minutes Monday to Saturday and by two hours on Sunday.

The amended hours applied for are therefore as follows:-
