


Tower Hamlets Covid-19 Update

Tower Hamlets rolling weekly rates vs rest of London:





- Levels continuing to fall but not yet stabilised
- Slight increase in 17-24 year olds
- Levels low in 60+
- Just over 90,000 residents have received first dose and 21,000 second dose
 - Disparities reducing in Bangladeshis population
 - Not improving so fast in the Black populations * = figures at last OSC

Priority issues



- 1. Vaccination uptake rates are dropping
 - Arts Pavilion not being used to capacity even when there is supply
 - Walk in model being adopted for eligible groups (upscaled comms)
- 2. Ongoing risk of Variants of Concern
 - Surge testing in a number of London borough (SA Variant)
 - High positivity in people returning from India (Indian Variant not VOC)
- 3. Easing lockdown
 - So far EH and Police have not see significant issues
 - 17th May important milestone

The best of London in one borough

Roadmap out of lockdown – step 3 (May 17)



- Outdoor gatherings up to 30 allowed
- Indoors rule of 6 or two households
- Businesses can reopen but COVID secure guidance required
- Indoor hospitality opens people need to remain seated
- Indoor entertainment opens (eg cinemas, children's play areas)
- Indoor accommodations opens (eg hotels and B and Bs)
- Indoor and outdoor events open with limitation on number
- Up to 30 can attend life events (eg weddings, wakes etc)
- Before step 4, government will complete review of social distancing and other measures eg use of face coverings
