



Dear Sir,

Central East Police Licensing formally object to the application for a Temporary Event Notice for Boat Live, 90 White Post Lane, E9 5EN, on the 7th October 2023. This objection is on the grounds of Public Safety.

At the recent hearing for a premises license for Boat Live, Tower Hamlets Councils Environmental Health officer made representations regarding the safety of the venue. These concerns are listed below.

Means of escape in case of emergency

Capacity not set for each area.

There needs to be a clear exit route for each area on the site

Trip hazards such as base of the structure in the year and step up to the container.

Safe Movement between the sections of the boat

Currently customers would have to step over a wall about 70 cm high

Ventilation

Will all doors and windows on the boat being closed to reduce noise escape the ventilation may not be adequate.

Electrical Safety

A certificate for the fixed wiring on the site has not been provided.

If the TEN were to be granted while these Health and Safety concerns were still resolved then there is a very real risk that people could be injured while events were taking place. The applicant has so far not provided any evidence that the above concerns have been addressed, and therefore the risk remains.

We therefore ask that this TEN is refused by the committee.

Should the applicant be able to demonstrate that these concerns have addressed to our satisfaction, then we will withdraw our objection.
