## <u>Local Community Fund Programme October 2022-October 2023</u> <u>Profile Of Beneficiaries</u>

## 1. Protected Characteristics

- 68.9% of the beneficiaries (20,772 people) were from Black, Asian & Multiethnic communities. Bangladeshi was the ethnic group with the highest percentage of beneficiaries, with 36.5% (11,000 people), followed by White British, with 21.9% (6,610 people).<sup>1</sup>
- 59.8% of beneficiaries were women (15,699 people) and 39.7% were men (10,423 people)
- The projects supported 18,477 individuals who reported they had a disability. This included:
  - 7,309 beneficiaries reporting having a long-standing illness or health condition
  - ❖ 5,023 beneficiaries reporting having a mental health condition
  - ❖ 3,101 beneficiaries reporting having a physical impairment
  - 1,105 beneficiaries reporting having a learning disability
  - ❖ 759 beneficiaries reporting having a sensory impairment
- 9.2% of beneficiaries were 65+ (2,860 people)
- The percentage of beneficiaries from LGBT groups was 3.6%.
