1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1.1 At its meeting on 16 October 2024 the Cabinet considered the report of the Corporate Director, Communities reviewing the Cumulative Impact Assessment Policy.
- 1.2 The report as set out was agreed at that meeting.

The Council should note paragraph 9.11 of the Policy, which states if there are no representations, the Council must grant the application in terms that are consistent with the operating schedule submitted, in line with the Council's delegated authority."

3. That the proposed Cumulative Impact Assessment, as part of the Statement of Licensing Policy will take effect from 20th November 2024 until 20th November 2027. The existing Cumulative Impact Policy, which is contained in Appendix 5 of the Statement of Licensing Policy will be rescinded on the 18th November 2024.
