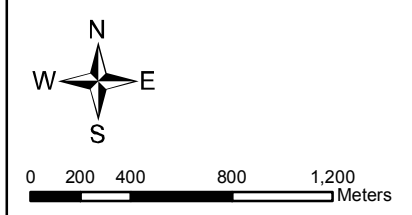

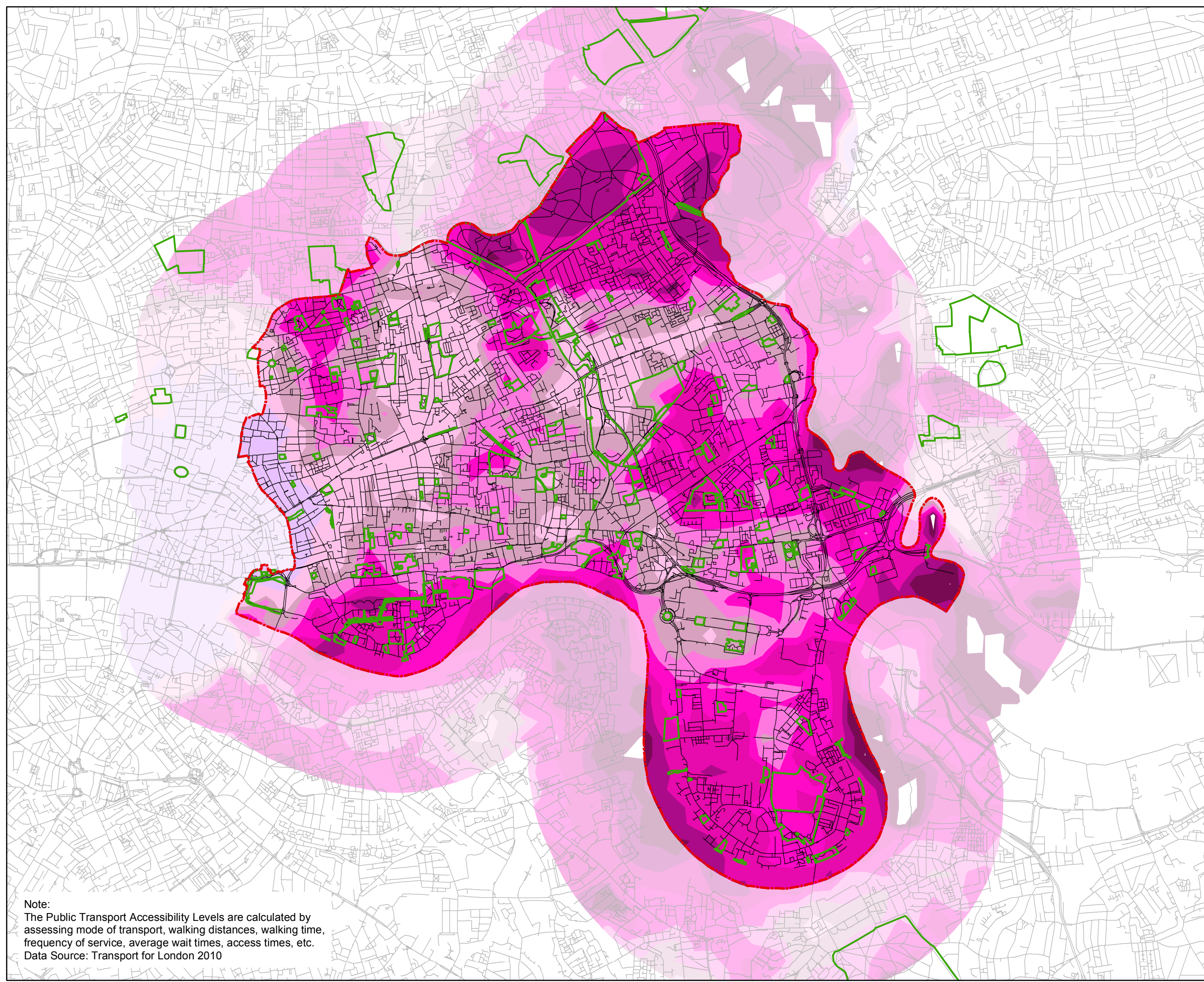

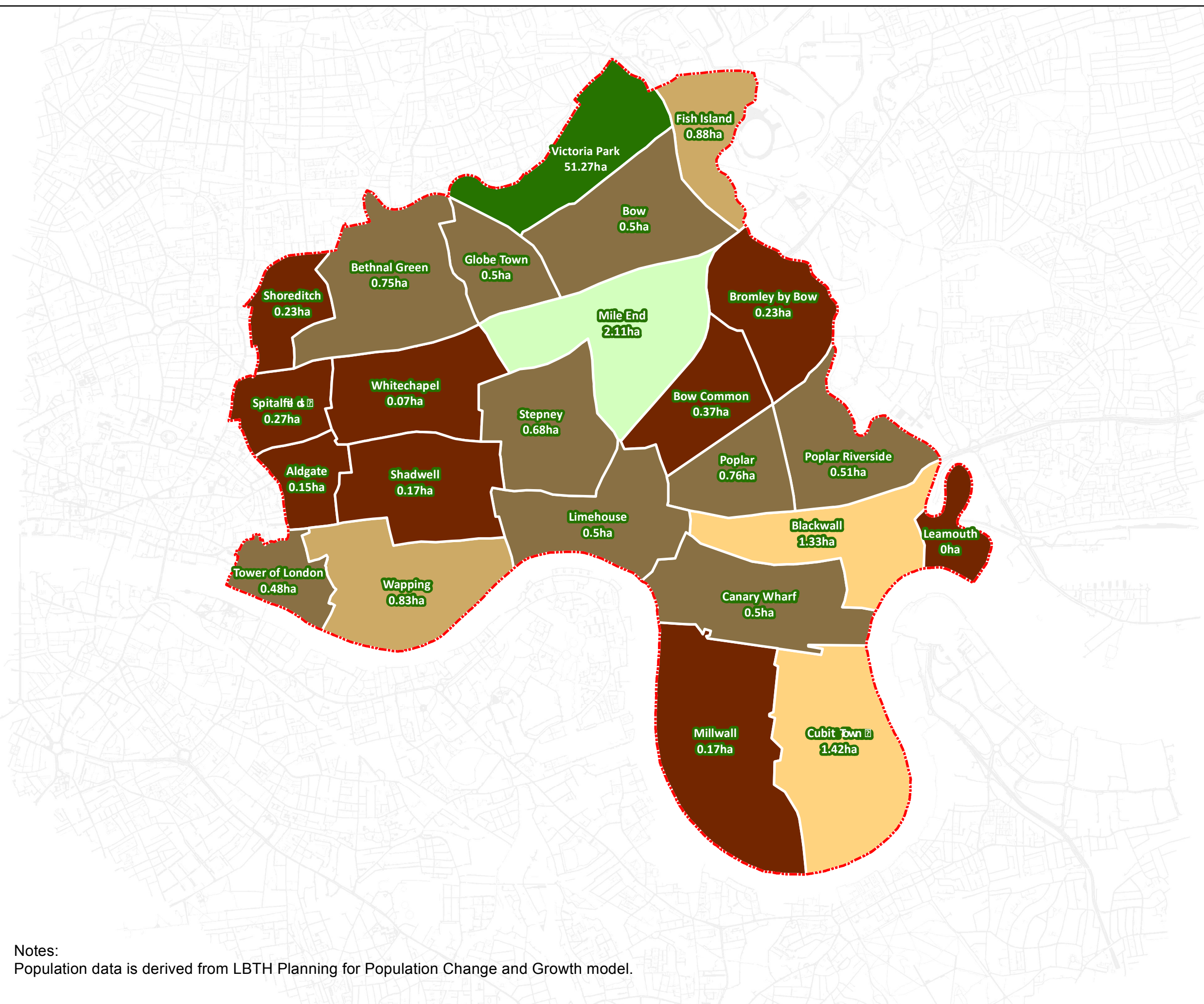
Area of Publicly Accessible Open Space in Hectares per 1000 Population (2010 Population)

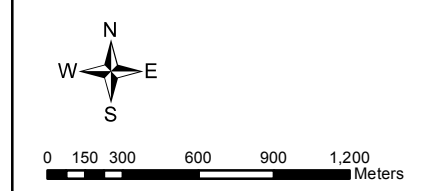
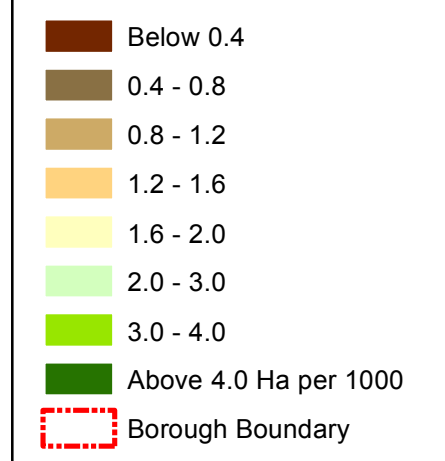

Area of Publicly Accessible Open Space in Hectares per 1000 Population (2025 Population)

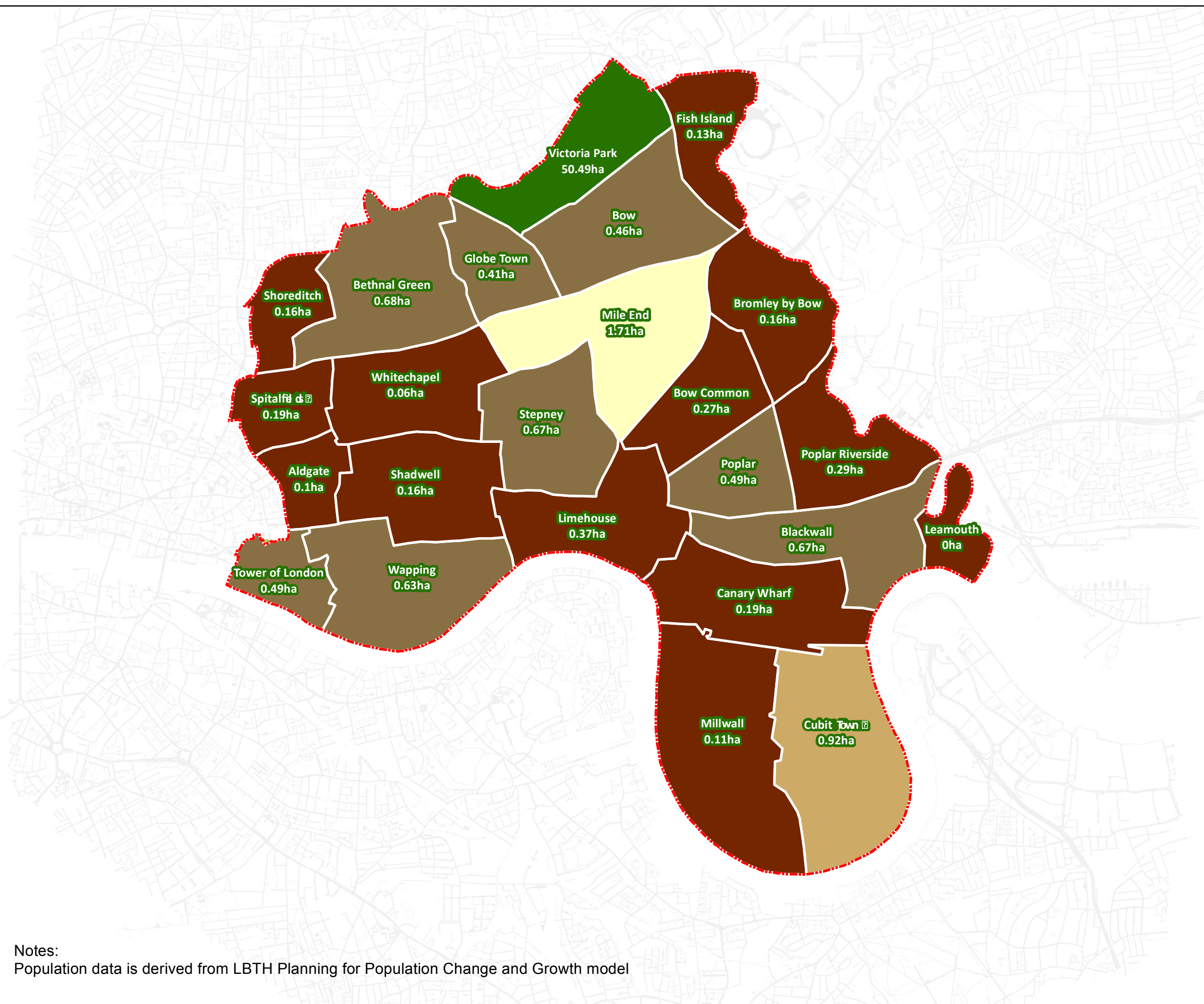
