## Nature of Decision/Recommendation required:

- S Approve the use of Construction Line for the procurement of the Contractor for the Decent Homes Programme in 2012/13
- S Approve the award of the 2012/13 Decent Homes Contract worth circa £4m to Apollo.
- S Delegate to the Corporate Director in consultation with Assistant Chief Executive (Legal Services) to enter into all necessary documents to implement the decisions made in respect of this report.

## Reason why it is impractical to provide 28 clear days' notice of the decision:

The Contractor need to commence mobilisation of resources for a timely start on site to ensure delivery of:

- § the remaining number of DHs necessary to meet the HCA's annual target of 686 Decent Homes in 2012/13
- § the required spend necessary to meet the HCA's annual target of £11m in 2012/13.

Meeting the HCA's annualised spend and DH output targets are conditional for unlocking the HCA's future funding for the DH Programme totalling £71m for 2013/14 & 2014/15.
