



2014

I write with reference to the above application which was received in the Licensing Office on the 24th July 2014.

Police object the application for a Temporary Event Notice for the 24th August 2014 on the grounds of Crime and Disorder and Prevention of Public Nuisance.

The Temporary Event Notice is for an event at 3 Hancock Road, Bromley by Bow on Notting Hill Carnival Weekend. This is a weekend when Police resources are incredibly stretched.

By having a dance music event that runs from 2:00pm to 11:00 where people will be consuming alcohol during that time, runs the risk of creating alcohol related crime and disorder.

Such events also attract drug use and where there is drug use there are drug dealers who supply them.

While under normal circumstances Police would be able to work with promoters and venue operators to ensure the safe running of the event, during Notting Hill there are simply not the resources available to do this.

This is demonstrated as at the last event at Hancock Road on the 27th July, Police were called to deal with a fight that broke out at the venue. The incident required additional Police to be deployed to the venue.

Given that this is not a venue specifically designed to host such events, and that there is the possibility of alcohol related disorder and drug use we therefore object to the Temporary Event Notice being granted and ask that it is refused by committee.

Please accept this email as a representation against the TEN application for 3 Hancock Rd on the 24th August 2014.

The site is an open air venue that has had events previously.

I attended a call from a local resident on Sunday 27th July 2014. I visited the event first and spoke with the organiser. I advised him the reason of my visit and he lowered the Funktion 1 sound system that was playing dance/house music. I also commented on the strong smell of cannabis throughout the site. There were nearly 400 people in attendance, and when I asked the SIA door supervisors if they had confiscated any drugs, they said 'no' and that the guests hide them.

I then attended the complainants property and could clearly hear a bass beat thumping on their balcony and inside their property. The couple were very reasonable and said that they didn't mind a one off event, but this has been happening most weekends through the summer, and were now at the end of their tether with the fact that they are unable to have peaceful enjoyment of their property during the weekend especially the day before the new working week.

The site is not conducive to open air events as the area has a lot of hard, reflective surfaces along with the canal, that just reverberate sound around the area, with very little absorption.

It is our recommendation that this TEN is cancelled.
