



Dear Bruno,

Tower Hamlets Police also object to the Temporary Event Notice on the grounds of Crime and Disorder.

On the 27th July 2014 at the same venue another late night dance event was held which resulted in a call to Police as a fight had broken out at the venue, upon arrival Police units requested another unit to attend due to the situation.

This is in essence a day time "Rave" where people will gather to dance to electronic dance music. With this type of event there is always the possibility of drug use and as we say at the event last weekend, violence. By having this event as part of a Temporary Event Notice, no conditions can be imposed upon the event, there is no security plan agreed with Police, or noise management plan agreed with the Local Authority. As a results stretched public services are having to pick up the peice's when things invariably go wrong.

Because of the risk of crime and disorder Tower Hamlets Police formally object to this Temporary Event Notice and ask for it to be refused.

Dear all, please accept this as a representation against this application for a Late TEN.

I attended this address last night in relation to a noise complaint from a local resident. Even after I attended site and spoke to Bruno who reduced the levels, the music was clearly audible in the complainants property. I could also clearly hear the bass beat over 100m away.

The site is not suitable for an outside event using a Funktion 1 type sound system playing house/dance type music.

This would cause considerable Public Nuisance and should therefore not go ahead.
