I am PC Corcoran, I am the dedicated the ward officer for Stepney and St Dunstan's Safer Neighbourhood team.							
I have the responsibility for the policing of the above wards and therefore have a greater knowledge of the issues							
and problems that affect the wards and the Surrounding areas.							
The address Spice Hut, 220 Mile End Road is known to me as being a place that attracts anti social behaviour and							
as a result it spills out across into neighbouring areas. The venue has attracted criminal activity in relation to							
thefts and when assistance has been asked for , staff have been hesitant. Cris Nos: 4225019/13- Theft .4231907/130-							
Common Assault, 4223323/14- Common Assault, 423303 t/t4- Theft. I am also aware they often breach their opening							
hours, serving later than they should. The antisocial behaviour affects several key ABS Hotspots, these being							
Stayner's Road, E1, Beaumont Square/Louisa Terrace, E1 and then also the area of Captain Cooks Yard and							
O'Leary Square. In relation to Stayners Road, I have personally stopped groups of males engaged in smoking							
cannabis, N02 capsule selling and other manners they have been in possession of fried chicken boxes from the							
shops, also when asked they have said that they are getting food from the Chicken Shop over the road. A number							
of these males have Asbo conditions to not congregate in more than 3. When getting food this occurs.							
Louisa Gardens, I have had regular phone calls from residents who live in the street that state that youths attend							
there smoking drugs, making loud noise and eating fried chicken, who are making a mess and throwing the litter							
and food all over the place. The only Chicken place that facilitates this is the Spice Hut on Mile End road.							
Captain Cooks Yard is constantly filled with litter and the remains of fried chicken boxes coming from the shop,							
contributing to the unsanitary and unseemly health hazard that is there. The fact that there is ready access to a hot							
food store till the early hours of the morning encourages the males engaged in drug dealing, both Cannabis/Khat							
and Class A drugs along with the antisocial gatherings that occur.							
O'Leary square is affected in much the same way as Capitan Cooks Yard, its only through persistent efforts of the							
police has the ASB been reduced. But often fried chicken boxes can be found in gardens (front and back) and in							
the hallways.
