This statement is made in relation to CAD5723/20NOV20.

On FRIDAY 20TH NOVEMBER 2020, I was in full uniform in company with PC WESTMAAS 1255CE in a marked police vehicle, call sign CE679L. My role for the day was to attend any breach of COVID regulation calls.

At approximately 1740 hours, I was made aware via my PR that a member of public had reported to the police that THE QUEENS HEAD PUB, FLAMBOROUGH STREET, E14 was in breach of COVID regulations. The remarks on the CAD stated 'THERE ARE A GROUP OF PEOPLE DRINKING AND MAKING NOISE'.

At approximately 1800 hours as I was arriving in the police vehicle, I witnessed an IC1 female, approximately late twenties/early thirties come out of a side door of the pub. I realised after that this was the main entrance of THE QUEENS HEAD. The blinds were down on all windows however the lights were on as they were shining through the blinds. The window on the immediate right of the main door had the blind down however it was approximately two inches short from the window sill. I could see another two females, both IC1 and of large build, sat at the bar, drinking from glasses. I noticed there were also a number of glasses lined up on the bar. There were approximately ten – fifteen glasses, some empty and some half full with drink.

I knocked on the window that I could see through and as I did both females immediately stood up from their bar stools and ran through a door opposite the window I was looking through. I could no longer see them, I knocked again but no one came to the door.
