



#### Mudchute Park and Farm





Dear Sir,

Central East Police Licensing formally object to the application for a Temporary Event Notice (TEN's) for Mudchute City Farm for the 24<sup>th</sup> July 2021. This objection is on the grounds of preventing Crime and Disorder and Public Nuisance.

I have spoken to the applicant and this is an application for a music festival to run from 11am until 11pm. We do not have any information on who this festival is targeted at, we do not have an event management plan, a security plan or an access or egress plan.

Music festivals require detailed planning with risks of people getting drunk, drug taking, violence and disorder, not to mention noise management and first aid plans. We have none of this information. To allow a music festival to go ahead without ensuring these key safety measures are not only effective, but in place would run the risk of not only crime and disorder taking place but also risks to public safety.

We therefore request that this TEN is rejected.
