



Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-

- a) at a time where there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence

3.

- (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy
- (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—
 - (a) a holographic mark, or

- (b) an ultraviolet feature.
- 5. 1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
 - 2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1—
 - (a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
 - (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula —
 P = D + (D x V)

where —

- (i) **P** is the permitted price
- D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence
 - (i) the holder of the premises licence
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence
- (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994
- 3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax

(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

- 1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of the Tower Hamlets Police Licensing Team.
 - a. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition.
 - b. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises.
 - c. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping.
 - d. Viewing of recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Police or authorised officer throughout the entire 31day period.
- A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises are open. This staff member must be able to provide a Police or authorised council officer copies of recent CCTV images or data with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
- 3. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and be available on request to the Police or an authorised officer. It must be completed within 24 hours of any incident and will record the following:
 - a. all crimes reported to the venue;
 - b. all ejections of patrons;
 - c. any complaints received concerning crime and disorder
 - d. any incidents of disorder;
 - e. all seizures of drugs or offensive weapons;
 - f. any faults in the CCTV system, searching equipment or scanning equipment;
 - g. any refusal of the sale of alcohol;
 - h. any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
- 4. A Challenge 25 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS Hologram.
- 5. A record shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The record should include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The record shall be available for inspection at the premises by the police or an authorised officer at all times whilst the premises is open.

- 6. Staff training shall be provided at regular intervals on, the sales of alcohol, underage sales and Health & Safety regulations.
- 7. There shall be no consumption of alcohol outside the premises.
- 8. Off sales shall be in sealed containers only.
- A standard age verification check shall be undertaken on entering the website. A
 signature at the point of delivery must be obtained. No delivery shall be left without
 a signature. Every third-party courier delivery box shall be labelled with the words
 "Age Restricted Product".
- 10. Alcohol shall only be delivered to a residential or business address and not to a public place.
- 11. No Music or Amplified Sound shall be generated on the premises to give rise to a nuisance to neighbouring residents.
- 12. Loudspeakers shall not be located in the entrance lobby or outside the premise building.
- 13. All windows and external doors shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment takes place, except for the immediate access & egress of persons.
- 14. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and businesses and leave the area quietly.
- 15. Patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises, e.g. to smoke, shall be limited to 5 persons at any one time.
- 16. No noise generated on the premises, or by its associated plant or equipment, shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to a nuisance.




- 1. All sales of alcohol are to be for consumption off the premises only.

- (1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises
- (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises:
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
 - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
 - (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability

2. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

3.

- (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy
- (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—
 - (a) a holographic mark, or
 - (b) an ultraviolet feature.
- 4. The responsible person must ensure that—
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;
 - (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
 - (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.
- 5. 1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
 - 2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1—
 - (a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
 - (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula —
 P = D + (D x V)
 where —

(i) **P** is the permitted price

- D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) **V** is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence
 - (i) the holder of the premises licence
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence
- (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994
- 3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax
 - (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

- 1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of the Tower Hamlets Police Licensing Team. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Viewing of recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Police or authorised officer throughout the entire 31day period.
- A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises are open. This staff member must be able to provide a Police or authorised council officer copies of recent CCTV images or data with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
- 3. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and be available on request to the Police or an authorised officer. It must be completed within 24 hours of any incident and will record the following:
 - a) all crimes reported to the venue;
 - b) all ejections of patrons;
 - c) any complaints received concerning crime and disorder
 - d) any incidents of disorder;
 - e) all seizures of drugs or offensive weapons;
 - f) any faults in the CCTV system, searching equipment or scanning equipment;
 - g) any refusal of the sale of alcohol;
 - h) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service.
- 4. A Challenge 25 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS Hologram.
- 5. A record shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The record should include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The record shall be available for inspection at the premises by the police or an authorised officer at all times whilst the premises is open.
- 6. Staff training shall be provided at regular intervals on, the sales of alcohol, underage sales and Health & Safety regulations.

- 7. There shall be no consumption of alcohol outside the premises.
- 8. Off sales shall be in sealed containers only.
- 9. A standard age verification check shall be undertaken on entering the website. A signature at the point of delivery must be obtained. No delivery shall be left without a signature. Every third-party courier delivery box shall be labelled with the words "Age Restricted Product".
- 10. Alcohol shall only be delivered to a residential or business address and not to a public place.
- 11. No Music or Amplified Sound shall be generated on the premises to give rise to a nuisance to neighbouring residents.
- 12. Loudspeakers shall not be located in the entrance lobby or outside the premise building.
- 13. All windows and external doors shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment takes place, except for the immediate access & egress of persons.
- 14. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and businesses and leave the area quietly.
- 15. Patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises, e.g. to smoke, shall be limited to 5 persons at any one time.
- 16. No noise generated on the premises, or by its associated plant or equipment, shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to a nuisance.





Dear Sir,

Central East Police Licensing formally object to the application for a Temporary event notice application for the 26th February 2022 for CABBY'S RUM BAR, ARCH 411, ST PAULS WAY, E3 4AG. On the grounds of Crime and disorder, public safety and public nuisance. The operators of the venue have demonstrated that they have total disregard for authority and upholding the licensing objectives.

The most recent event demonstrating this, was the 4th February 2022 when police attended the venue.

Upon arrival is was very clear to police that an unlicensed event was taking place. Police witnessed Security staff not having their SIA identity clearly on show and initially refusing to identify themselves. Officers were refused entry into the venue by security staff, who placed a physical barrier across the gate to prevent officers entering.

The Designated premises supervisor was not on site. The various individuals claiming to be representing the operator had no idea of the license conditions for the venue. Police believe that allowing this temporary event to take place will undermine the licensing objectives set out in the 2003 licensing act.

Dear Licensing

I have regarded the application for the TENs for Cabby's Rum Bar Railway Arch, 411 St Pauls Way, London and the potential impact of public nuisance and measures to prevent noise generated from within the premises or outside it which could cause disturbance to people in the vicinity.

Recent history of noise complaints of loud amplified music emanating from the venue since 20th December 2021, includes six complaints from four different residents with:-

- 1. Several letters sent to the venue advising of noise complaints received.
- 2. 29/1/22 a visit was made to the vicinity when officers received a call from the control room in regards to a noise complaint made and liaised with the complainant at 00:27 who reported loud music coming from the premises. Officers then arrived in the vicinity of the noise source address at 00:39 when conducting their investigation could hear music and bass from 200m away where they had parked their vehicle. OOH officers spoke to the venue and they complied and turned music down
- 3. 30/1/22 officers visit to a resident following a report of loud music at 00:14 when again officers spoke to the venue, followed by a S80 noise abatement notice being served on 3rd February 2022 (see attached)

I do not believe that the Licensing Objective for the Prevention of Public Nuisance would be adhered to by allowing this TENs event to go ahead until 02:00 hours for licensable activities: sale of alcohol, regulated entertainment, late night refreshment, closing 30 minutes later at 02:30 hours. Visits undertaken by the Out of Hours noise service to the premises known as Cabby's Rum Bar, which is not currently licensed for regulated entertainment after 2300 hours, have witnessed the playing of loud music after 23:00 hours, and causing a noise nuisance to residents.

In my opinion the Current License, as it stands, fails to comply with the objective of the Licensing Act 2003 relating to "public nuisance" for the following reasons:-

- Noise breakout from the venue affecting neighbouring residents.
- Access and egress to and from the venue, by patrons, especially due to patrons likely to be in high spirits; and
- The hours of operation.

CONCLUSION

Environmental Protection **does not** support the TENs application for Cabby's Rum Bar Railway Arch, 411 St Pauls Way, London, as there is great likelihood of disturbance to residential premises at the noise sensitive hours sought, particularly when given the recent history of noise complaints.
