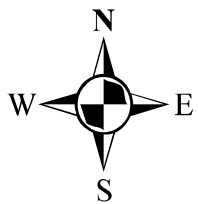

 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over

a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;

(d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;

(e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability)

2. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

3.

(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy

(3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—

(a) a holographic mark, or

(b) an ultraviolet feature.

4. The responsible person must ensure that—

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—

(i) beer or cider: ½ pint

(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;

(b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and

(c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that

these measures are available.

5.
 1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
 2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1—
 - (a) “duty” is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
 - (b) “permitted price” is the price found by applying the formula —
$$P = D + (D \times V)$$
where —
 - (i) **P** is the permitted price
 - (ii) **D** is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
 - (iii) **V** is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
 - (c) “relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence
 - (i) the holder of the premises licence
 - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
 - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence
 - (d) “relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
 - (e) “value added tax” means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994
 3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
 4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day (“the first day”) would be

different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax

- (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day

2. Signs asking patrons to leave "quietly to be displayed at the premises.
3. No children in the bar at any time

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

1. There shall be no off sales.
2. No drinks shall be taken outside the premises.
3. No more than 10 smokers allowed to smoke outside the premises at any one time.
4. CCTV camera system covering both internal and external to the premises is to be installed.
 - a. The CCTV recordings are to be maintained for 30 days and to be provided upon request to either a police officer or any officer of any other Responsible Authority.

Dear Licensing

I have reviewed the four TENS applications for The Lighthouse 421 Wick Lane, London and have considered the potential impact of public nuisance and measures to prevent noise generated from within the premises or outside it which could cause disturbance to people in the vicinity.

Since 8th February 2022 we have received six noise complaints (from two different residents) regarding loud amplified music/DJs, and ASB from patrons outside the venue, so I do not believe the licensing objective for the Prevention of public nuisance would be met by allowing these TENS to go ahead:-

3 rd July 2022 (ref 150465)	until 03:00 hours (an extension of four and a half hours on existing licence hours for Sunday)
10 th -11 th July 2022 (ref 150461)	until 02:00 hours (an extension of four and a half hours on existing licence hours for Sunday)
23 rd July 2022 (ref 150466)	until 02:30 hours (an extension of two and a half hours on existing licence hours for Saturday)
31 st July to 1 st August (ref 150462)	until 03:00 hours (an extension of four and a half hours on existing licence hours for Sunday)

Noise Sensitive premises: residential and commercial premises in close proximity to The Lighthouse PH 421 Wick Lane London

In my view the application, as it stands fails, to comply with the objective of the Licensing Act 2003 relating to “public nuisance” for the following reasons:-

- Noise breakout from the venue affecting neighbouring residents.
- Access & egress to and from the venue, of patrons, especially due to patrons likely to be in high spirits; and
- The hours of operation (inclusive of proposals)

CONCLUSION

Environmental Protection **does not** support the four TENS applications for The Lighthouse PH 421 Wick Lane London as there is great likelihood of disturbance to residential premises at the noise sensitive hours sought.

Email received from complainant to Noise team with regards to The Lighthouse PH:

- Noise coming from inside and outside the property every Sunday evening from about 8pm to 11.30pm.
- There is a DJ that plays every Sunday evening and has done so for a number of weeks.
- Patrons congregating outside to smoke and are very loud
- Patrons noisy when leaving at the end of the night.
- Warning letter sent to venue and diary sheets to complainant

337175 – 13/3/22 OOH visit

Complainant reported loud music coming from The Lighthouse Pub.

From previous events it goes on until 00:00 every Sunday and the noise had started today around 19:30, occurring every weekend for past 3 months.

OOH officers liaised with the complainant at 21:54 hours who reported loud music coming from The Lighthouse Pub. Complainant stated that based on previous events it goes on until 00:00 every Sunday and the noise had started today around 19:30, and that it has been occurring every weekend from the past 3 months. Officer arrived in the vicinity of the noise source address at 22:13 hours. Officers parked vehicle 100m away from the noise source address:

- we could hear clearly Caribbean type music emanating from the venue
- several patrons outside talking and smoking and as we came closer to the venue we could hear the music above the traffic noise on the busy highway
- Officers engaged with the door supervisor at the venue and officers had to raise voice to be heard to request to speak to the DPS.
- Once the DPS was located we advised them that the music audible levels were unacceptable for the location and in our opinion unnecessary and excessive for the type of venue.
- The DPS was very apologetic and agreed to lower the volume to a more reasonable level, which they complied with immediately, we thanked the DPS before departing and monitoring for a short time with no further issue to report.

337869 – 3/4/22 OOH call

Complainant reported loud music coming from The Lighthouse Pub. Complainant stated that based on previous events it goes on until before 01:00 every Sunday. Due to refusing a home assessment call was only logged

338110 – 10/4/22 OOH visit

Entered complainant's property at:22:48 hours and carried out assessment in complainant's living room with windows open and closed T.V. on at a reasonable level could still hear the bass and people shouting outside the venue.

338541 – 24/4/22 – OOH call

Complainant reported loud music coming from the Lighthouse Pub. Complainant stated that there is an issue of people being outside and loud music. Complainant stated that their license states that there shouldn't be more than 4 people outside and that there is a heavy bass that keeps vibrating into their property.

After unsuccessfully trying to contact the complainant officers were unable to arrange a home assessment as required.

339991 – 5/6/22 – OOH visit

Call received advising that the music from the Lighthouse PH starts at 7pm and lasts until 2300 where the music then stops. There are times when the music increases in volume to a level that can be heard throughout the property. Home assessment agreed.

Officers entered complainant's premises at 21:29 hours and carried out an assessment with complainant's living room windows open and closed. Officers couldn't hear music with tv off. Officers said music levels were not intrusive would not prevent sleep or prevent a person watching tv. Statutory noise nuisance not witnessed. Left site at 21:48 Hours.
