Introduction.

I have been asked to conduct an unannounced and impartial compliance visit on club premises at Club Oops! 30 Alie Street E1 8DA.

The premises currently operate until 04.00hrs and can provide licensable activities (supply of alcohol, music and dance) until 03.30hrs throughout the week.

I conducted the compliance audit at 22.05hrs on the following date –

Thursday 24th March 2022.

Personal – Mark Halton.

I have retired from the Metropolitan Police Service, completing 30 year's exemplary service.

1985-1987 Westminster Response team police officer

1987-1997 Central Clubs & Vice Unit CO14 posting within as follows

1987-88 Street Offences Squad dealing with street prostitution, brothels, massage parlors, illegal gaming/casino and both licensed and unlicensed venues for the sale of alcohol.

1988-90 Obscene Publications Unit.

1990- 93 Field Intelligence officer CO14 Clubs & Vice. Covert policing, surveillance.

An undercover drugs test purchaser and financial investigator used primarily in the night club economy specialising in nightclubs and bars. 1993-97 Clubs & Vice Licensing Unit. Supervising and dealing with licensing prosecutions, administration, and applications.

1997-01 Westminster Borough Licensing Co-Coordinator. Supervising all licensing teams within the Borough, modifying police process's particularly prosecutions.

2002-06 Westminster Police Licensing Team. Set up the unit and supervised, wrote the crime reduction management document, and assisted with the Westminster Statement of Licensing Policy.

2007-10 Camden Borough Police Response Team Supervisor.

2010-12 Police Licensing Advisor Home Office. Secondment.

Ran and supervised the Home Office Intensive Support Visit program (ISV) supplying training on legislation, powers and practical implementation to police forces and local authorities nationally. Completed submissions for response to Prime Ministerial Questions (PMQs), advice to various ministers including the Home Secretary. Wrote the then Home Office guidance on expedited reviews and section 19 closure notices. Sat on the boards of Best Bar None, Pub Watch and Purple Flag. During this time assisted in the licensing of the Olympics 2012.

2013-15 Richmond Borough Police Licensing Team. Supervised and organised the police licensing for the Rugby World Cup 2015.

Since retirement I have completed numerous overt and covert licensing visits to SEV premises assisting with and ensuring compliance. I have recently been approached by a London licensing authority to give expert witness testimony against a venue that benefits from an SEV which it is allegedly breaching. I do because of my previous policing experience and work post my service consider myself to be an expert within this field.

A Home Office qualified Crime Reduction Officer, Crime Prevention Design Advisor and CCTV system approved officer. An expert in crime reduction measures and getting venues experiencing such problems back on track.

Independent Compliance Visit

•	Full premises inspection record at annex A.
•	I entered the venue at 22.05hrs.
•	There are 2 security at the main entrance. Both security have SIA badges, both clearly displayed.
•	There is no queue, and the street is very quiet. No customers outside and no vehicles with engines running. Intermittently throughout the night I return to the front of the venue during the visit the situation remains the same no noise throughout from custom or vehicles.
•	On entry to the venue. I see the premises licence summary clearly and correctly displayed. On the reception counter/bar, I see the following Daily Incident Report and Security Time Sheet, Customer Daily Entry Sheet, Staff and Visitors Sign in, Fire Exit Check Sheet and Performers Daily Entrance/Exit Sheet. All clearly visible, legible and up to date.

visible. This is duplicated within toilet cubicles.

• There is a notice re the zero tolerance drugs policy, age verification system and the code of conduct for customers, directly in front of you upon entry and clearly

•	There is a further member of security safeguarding the entrance to the 1 st floor VIP area and a second guarding the entrance to the rear room used for lap dancing. All have SIA badges clearly visible. Ensuring 4 security on duty.
•	I am also introduced to a new member of staff, who is employed as the house mother and bar manager. Her role is to look after the welfare of the performers employed at the venue, ensuring they are safe and treated responsibly by staff and custom. I must say that in all my visits to the venue, I have not once witnessed any such behavior within the venue.
•	There is further signage on the reception reminding patrons that no physical contact with the performers is allowed. All house rules including this located on all tables.
•	There is a sign on the reception informing customers that the manager is Nicky.
•	I am informed that the entry fee is £12 and that a lap dance is £20 per music track. The dancer is not allowed to take money directly from the customer. The customer or dancer must purchase a token from the bar in exchange for £20. The dancer is then given a token for the dance. No token no dance. An element of control implemented by the venue. Commendable.

•	Mai Wing Nicky Chan is the DPS. He is a personal licence holder (plh) at the
	venue, along with the owner Santosh Nair. There is a notice of delegated
	authority in the office and behind the bar displayed showing in the absence of Mr.
	Chan, persons authorised to sell alcohol. Signed by all.

- A customer code of conduct set of rules are displayed on each table with the drink's menu. This is replicated on the 1st floor lap dancing booths and VIP area. The rules are clear and precise.
- The atmosphere was relaxed and comfortable on the night. I saw no evidence of drunkenness and crime and disorder throughout the visit. I saw no evidence of inappropriate behavior between performers and customers.
- I further observed and went through in detail all the conditions on the Premises licence, SEV licence and consent order. All complied with on the night.
- All the conditions on the premises licence being Mandatory, agreed with police, EHO, fire service and by committee are again fully complied with. The measures are fully incorporated at the venue.

Conclusion.

The venue continues to rigorously review its systems and procedures even when there are no issues. Mr Chan is now the DPS at the venue. This has been a smooth handover and had no negative effect on the venue.

I have conducted numerous visits at this venue. As a result of these compliance visits, operating systems have been put in place. The standard has not dropped and the venue with its good management continues to vigorously uphold the licensing objectives and listen to its neighbours. Club Oops! Continues to be a community aware venue. The owners and management are reactive to the concerns of police, local authority, residents and the surrounding business community.

Throughout my audit I again note the following key points.

No noise was audible when outside at the front and rear from inside the venue.

The numbers of security personnel are far more than other venues of a similar size and or nature.

During my visit, there are eight performers working and twelve customers. All performers right to work documentation checked and compliant.

There was no evidence of drunkenness, violent crime or anti-social behavior on my night's visit.

There was no evidence of drug dealing or misuse in the external area or venue.

I have swiped all flat surfaces within toilet area with drugs wipes, all proved negative.

The conduct of staff and performers was compliant with both the premises licence and SEV.

Dispersal from the venue by security was impressive, customers are led to taxi, or leave quietly on foot, the pavement is kept clear. I personally witness this.

All matters relevant in the report on which my expert evidence is given has been included in this report. I believe the facts I state in this report are honest and true and that the opinions I have expressed are correct to the best of my judgement. The fee for this report is not conditional on the outcome of any future case, application or finding. My compliance visit was again unannounced.




