Re: Redbud (London) Ltd T/A Vanilla Thai Massage, 1 Whites Row, London E1 7NF

Reference is made to a recent application for a Special Treatment License for the above premises. An objection was lodged by the Licensing and Safety team of this Authority that the application should be refused. The reason for the objection is because the Authority has evidence that the proposed licence holder is not fit and proper to hold a licence, that the premises has been improperly conducted, and that the applicant Redbud (London) Ltd. has, within the period of five years immediately preceding this application been convicted of an offence under this Act. Thus, the application should be refused under Section 8(c), 8(e), and 8(l) of London Local Authorities Act 1991.

Brief History of the Premises

The applicant is Redbud (London) Ltd, submitted an application for a special treatment licence to this Authority on the 22nd June 2022. This application sought a licence to provide special treatments of massage at Vanilla Thai Massage, 1 Whites Row. Redbud (London) Ltd was granted a special treatment licence for this premises on 23rd March 2016 and renewed it annually. However, on 14th March 2019 the Licensing Committee refused the renewal of their special treatment licence because the licence holder has been found to have improperly

conducted its business on 27th March 2018 (offering service of a sexual nature).to view the full minutes of Licensing Committee Hearing on 14th March 2019 please see link below:

On the 23rd March 2019, Redbud (London) Ltd was also convicted at Thames Magistrates Court of three offences contrary to section 14(2) of the London Local Authorities Act 1991. This was due to the offering of services of a sexual nature, which is a breach of its special treatment licence conditions.

Ms Cheung Lai Kwan had held a special treatment licence for this premises since 18th October 2019, which was renewed annually. Then on the 16th and the 29th of October 2021, test purchases were carried out, which found that services of a sexual nature were being offered at the premises (see witness statements of the two test purchases in exhibits KAM.VTM.001 & 002). In light of this Ms Kwan's licence was revoked on the 14th July 2022 by the Licensing Committee see link below for the full minutes of the hearing:

It was noted that Companies House lists Ms Cheung Lai Kwan (previous Licence Holder) as a previous director of Redbud (London) Ltd (current applicant). Ms Cheung Lai Kwan resigned on the 6th April 2022 but was a director at the time when services of a sexual nature were found to be occurring in October 2021. (see exhibit KAM.VTM.004).

In summary,

- The premises has a proven history of being operated as a brothel-type establishment. It is likely that the clientele would continue to be the same as those who attended under the previous licence holder, and as such some will expect sexual services because the premises has offered this before.
- Two of the massage therapists in the new application, Christine Carard and Orapin Saingam, also worked under the previous licence holder (see the application form submitted by Redbud (London) Ltd in exhibit KAM.VTM.005 and the final application

form submitted by Cheung Lai Kwan in exhibit KAM.VTM.006). Therefore, some of the same therapists have remained in place after the change of ownership.

- Redbud (London) Ltd previously held a special treatment licence which was granted on 23rd March 2016 and renewed annually until 14th March 2019 when its renewal application was refused by Licensing Committee of this Authority for offering services of a sexual nature.
- On the 23rd March 2019, Redbud (London) Ltd was convicted at Thames Magistrates Court of three offences contrary to section 14(2) of the London Local Authorities Act 1991. This was due to the offering of services of a sexual nature.
- Ms Cheung Lai Kwan's special treatment licence was revoked by Licensing Committee on the 14th July 2022 due to test purchase visits on 16th and 29th October 2021 finding services of a sexual nature being offered. Ms Kwan was listed as a director of Redbud (London) Ltd. at the time of the test purchases visit in October 2021.

We believe that the above grounds render the applicant/proposed licence holder not fit and proper to hold a special treatment licence and we further assert that the premises has been operated in an improper manner.

Statement

1. I am [REDACTED] and I am employed by [REDACTED]

2. I was instructed by [REDACTED] to attend Vanilla Thai Spa, 1 White Row, London, E17NF in order to conduct a test purchase on behalf of the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.
3. At approximately 12:13 hrs on the 15th October 2021 I visited Vanilla Thai Spa, 1 White Row, London, E17NF.
4. On entering the reception area, the reception desk is to the right. To the left there was a massage chair and ornamental plants. Behind the plants was a black and white medical privacy screen that surrounded what looked to be a waiting area.
5. I approached the reception desk and was greeted by a female of Asian appearance who looked to be in her late twenties. She was wearing a blue face mask, a dark purple tunic, black trousers and flat black shoes.
6. I asked the female if I could have a massage and she replied, "sure how long would you like sir?". I said that I would like forty-five minutes. The female then said that that would be £40 which I then gave her as 2 x £20 notes. The female asked me to follow her and then led me to an area past the waiting area. There were two small rooms to the right and a small room with a washing machine and shelves full of towels straight ahead.
7. The female showed me in to the first room on the right which had an inward opening door. She beckoned me inside while she remained at the door. She then told me to remove my clothes and pointed to some hangers and a small chair where she told me to put my clothes. She told me to lay down and make myself comfortable pointing to a massage table in the centre of the room. Just before

closing the door, she said that a lady will be with me very soon.

- 8. Inside the room there was a shower and sink to the right and two candles burning on small shelves in the far left and right corners. I stripped down to my boxer shorts and laid face-down on the table with a towel covering my upper legs and lower back. About a minute later another female entered the room. She appeared to be in her late twenties and was wearing a dark face mask, the same dark purple tunic as the receptionist, black trousers and black flat shoes. This female had a waist belt with an oil dispenser attached to it.*
- 9. We exchanged pleasantries and she asked if I had been here before to which I said no. She then moved the towel up slightly and said, "you take these off please" while touching my right hip. I asked if I needed to and she said yes as she will be using oil. I removed my boxer shorts and she held the towel in a way that I remained covered. I lay back on my front and she placed the towel so it covered my buttocks and legs. She then asked me if the music that was playing was ok and I said yes, it is very nice.*
- 10. The female then began the massage starting at my neck and shoulders. She then massaged my back and lumbar area before starting again at my feet and calves.*

After about 30-35 minutes, she began massaging my hamstrings and buttocks after moving the towel up so it only covered my back. At this point, she massaged very close to my genitals. She then told me to turn over and took the towel completely off me and placed it to one side.

The female then asked, "massage is ok?" and told her it was very relaxing. She then gestured by circling her hand over my groin area and said, "Shall I massage here?". I said, "sorry what do you mean?" and she replied, "You want a nice massage here?" again, making the same hand gesture. I declined the offer and she said, "ok maybe next time, yes".

The female then spent the last 5 minutes or so massaging my neck and putting my legs in stretching positions. At the end of the allotted time, she tapped my shoulders and said that the massage was over and asked if it was ok. I told her that it was very nice and thanked her. She told me to dress in my own time and to come out whenever I am ready.

Prior to leaving, the female said that I should come back and that there are many different girls that work on different days. I then dressed and returned to the reception area where the receptionist asked if everything was ok. I stated that it was very nice indeed and asked for a business card, but she said that they didn't have any left. I was informed that more were being printed and she wrote the number down on a piece of paper and handed it to me.

I thanked her again and left the premises at approximately 13:01 hrs

3. At approximately 11:27 hrs on the 29th October 2021 I visited Vanilla Thai Spa, 1 White Row, London, E1 7NF.
4. Upon entering the premises there was a reception area with a reception desk to the right. I approached the reception desk and was greeted by a female of Asian appearance who appeared to be in her late twenties. The female was wearing a black tunic, black trousers and flat back shoes. The tunic appeared to be a uniform and the female had auburn hair which appeared to be dyed.
5. I asked if I could have a massage and she replied, "yes ... how long for?". I said that I would like forty-five minutes. The female then asked if I wanted 'relaxing' or 'deep tissue' and I said that I would like relaxing. She then said that that would be £40 which I gave her as 2 x £20 notes.
6. The female asked me to follow her and then led me to an area past the waiting area. There were two small rooms to the right and a small room with a washing machine and shelves full of towels straight ahead. The female showed me in to the first room on the right which had an inward opening door. She beckoned me inside while she remained at the door.
7. The female told me to remove my clothes and pointed to some hangers and a small chair where she told me to put my clothes. The female told me that she would be back soon and, again, told me to remove my clothes and to lie down on the massage table that was in the centre of the room.

8. *Inside the room there was a shower and sink to the right and candles burning on small shelves in the far left and right corners. I stripped down to my boxer shorts and laid face-down on the table with a towel covering my upper legs and lower back.*
9. *About a minute later, the same female from the reception area entered the room. We exchanged pleasantries and some small talk about the currently inclement weather. The female momentarily lifted the towel before replacing it in roughly the same position.*
10. *The female asked if I was comfortable to which I replied that I was. She then began the massage by pressing downwards on my legs and back. The female then knelt on my hamstrings lightly and massaged my back. After this, she stood up on the table and then stood on my back and hamstrings.*

After a minute or so, the female climbed off the table and began a hand massage from my back and then on to my legs. She then stood at my head reached down to my boxers and pulled them half down exposing my buttocks but not removing the boxers any further. When she did this, she lightly smacked my buttocks and said, "I like to see your bum" and giggled.

The female then stood by my feet and began massaging my upper legs. At this point, she changed to very light touches which were very close to my genitals. The female then told me to turn over and took the towel completely off me and placed it to one side.

The female then asked, "you want special massage?". I asked what is a 'special massage' to which she said, "what kind of special massage you like?". At this stage, I got the impression she would not further describe what 'special massage' meant so I asked her how much is a 'special massage' to which she replied "how much you want to pay?" I then declined the offer and the female immediately said, "That's OK" and continued with the massage.

The female spent the last 5 minutes or so massaging my neck and putting my legs in stretching positions. At the end of the allotted time, she tapped my shoulders and said that the massage was over and asked if it was ok. I told her that it was very nice and thanked her.

The female told me to dress in my own time and to come out whenever I was ready. I then dressed and returned to the reception area where the same lady asked if I would like some water which I politely declined. I thanked her again and then exited the premises at approximately 12:14 hrs.



I enclose an application form along with the Rules applying to these type of premises. The current fee for the licence is **£375.00**. The fee for IPL is **£604.00** with or without any other treatment.

I must remind you that it is an offence to carry out any Special Treatments if you do not have a licence. If you commit an offence you may be liable to a fine of up to **£2,500**.
