Dear Licensing,

I have reviewed the four TENs applications for 9 Umberston Street London E1 1PY and have considered the potential impact of public nuisance and measures to prevent noise generated from within the premises or outside it which could cause disturbance to people in the vicinity.

Previous temporary events notice for 27^{th} August 2022, several noise complaints were received from loud amplified music from the premises so I do not believe the licensing objective for the Prevention of public nuisance would be met by allowing these TENs to go ahead for the hours of 20:000 hours to 03:00 hours in the morning on $24^{th} - 25^{th}$ December 2022.

Noise Sensitive premises: residential and commercial premises in close proximity to 9 Umberston Street London E1 1PY, as a high concentration of residential premises above and in close proximity.

In my view the application, as it stands fails, to comply with the objective of the Licensing Act 2003 relating to "public nuisance" for the following reasons:-

- Noise breakout from the venue affecting neighbouring res
- Access & egress to and from the venue, of patrons, especially due to patrons likely to be in high spirits;
- The hours of operation (inclusive of proposals)

CONCLUSION

Environmental Protection **does not** support the four TENs application for 9 Umberston Street London E1 1PY as I do not believe that the licensing objective for the prevention of public nuisance will be met, and there is a great likelihood of disturbance to residential premises at the noise sensitive hours sought.
