



Good morning Licensing,

I have regarded the TENs application for Fabwick Unit 4a Ground, Queens Yard, 43 White Post Lane, London the potential impact of public nuisance and measures to prevent noise generated from within the premises or outside it which could cause disturbance to people in the vicinity.

Due to ongoing noise complaints regarding a number of venues in Queens, whilst no evidence of a statutory noise nuisance has been established, I have to consider the licensing objective for the prevention of public nuisance, and the cumulative impact of public nuisance at the late hours sought.

<u>Noise Sensitive premises:</u> residential and commercial premises in close proximity to the premises including at Omega Works, 4 Roach Road, London, E3

In my view the application, as it stands fails, to comply with the objective of the Licensing Act 2003 relating to "public nuisance" for the following reasons:-

- Noise breakout from the venue affecting neighbouring residents.
- Access & egress to and from the venue, of patrons, especially due to patrons likely to be in high spirits; and
- The hours of operation (inclusive of proposals)

CONCLUSION

Environmental Protection does not support the application for Fabwick Unit 4a Ground, Queens Yard", 43 White Post Lane, London due to the greater likelihood of disturbance to residential premises at the noise sensitive hours sought.
